Create a leaflet/travel guide for an American city.	Write a song to name the countries of North or South America and perform it with a group of friends.	List American and English words e.g trousers vs pants rubbish vs garbage You could also look into pronunciation e.g how you say tomato in English but tom-ate-toe in American
Find out the height of the five tallest building/monuments in North or South America.	Use an atlas to compare a North and South American country using any human or physical feature of your choice. For example population/rainfall/climate.	Make a 3D map of North or South American using paper mache to show to terrain.
Create a mind map showing information you have found about either major rivers or major mountain ranges in the Americas.	Make and present a 6-slide PowerPoint presentation about a famous American from history.	Make a cake suitable for an Independence Day celebration. E.g decorated with an American flag
A fact file about a famous American artist or architect	Create your own menu for an American diner.	Create an 'Amazing Americas' homework of your own choice that is not on the homework grid. Remember to give it a date, title and make it great!
