#### Covid Update

This week we had our first (and hopefully last) covid outbreak in school, this directly effected the staff and pupils in Gazelle class. In line with the DfE guidance the class remained open but further restrictions were put into place to ensure that the class remained separate from the rest of the school. It continues to be a challenging time in schools and I want to personally thank the staff in school for adapting so well and to all the parents/carers who have followed our guidance we received from public health.

#### Reminders:

- We are still encouraging face coverings in the playground, if you choose not to wear one, please ensure that you remain over 2m away from school staff when speaking to them.
- If your child is unwell DO NOT send them into school. Please ring school and we will advise as to whether they need a PCR test or not. Please note that during a school outbreak, public health have advised us that all ill staff and pupils should be tested.
- Continue to take regular lateral flow tests, however if ill, then a PCR test is needed. Brighouse has a walk in centre, which is the quickest way to get tested.

Finally, please trust that any advise we provide is from the daily advise we receive in school from the DfE and public health. We want all the children and staff in school, but their safety is always at the forefront of our minds.
