The Importance of Reading at Home

During the school the day the children have a number of opportunities to read in and out of class, as a whole class, group or on a 1:1 basis. We are pleased with the progress the majority of children are making in their reading. Reading is equally as important at home, but we have a number of pupils who are not reading frequently enough, or at all, at home. We have invested a lot of time and school budget in purchasing high quality reading text, please encourage your child to read these with you and return them to school as often as possible.

Please support your child by spending 10 minutes each day reading with them on a 1:1 basis. Please ensure that you sign their reading record.

Covid Update

This week we have had further positive Covid cases in Lion and Giraffe Class. In line with the DfE guidance the class remained open but further restrictions were put into place.

Reminders:

- We are still encouraging face coverings in the playground, if you choose not to wear one, please ensure that you remain over 2m away from school staff when speaking to them.
- If your child is unwell DO NOT send them into school. Please ring school and we will advise as to whether they need a PCR test or not. Please note that while we have positive cases in school, public health have advised us that all ill staff and pupils should be tested.
- Continue to take regular lateral flow tests, however if ill, then a PCR test is needed. Brighthouse has a walk in centre, which is the quickest way to get tested.

Finally, please trust that any advise we provide is from the daily advise we receive in school from the DfE and public health. We want all the children and staff in school, but their safety is always at the forefront of our minds.
